Safeguarding

We all know that many young children and teenagers enjoy dressing up and going out to 'trick or treat' their neighbours and friends.

But for others, including some older people, Halloween can mean an anxious night worrying if groups of children will arrive on their doorstep to play tricks on them.

Here is some advice provided by the Police, before you go out trick or treating:

DON'T:

- Go alone.
- Go into any houses.
- Be rude or abusive.

DO:

- Make sure you have an adult with you.
- Take extra care when crossing roads.
- Only travel in familiar, well-lit areas and stay with friends.
- Ensure costumes/accessories are fire-resistant and dress brightly so you can be seen.
- Use reflective tape or glow-sticks.
- Only knock on doors of homes displaying Halloween decorations.
