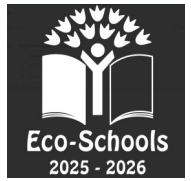




News from Great Alne Primary School

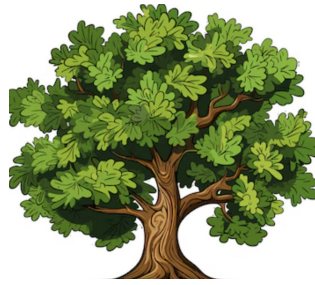
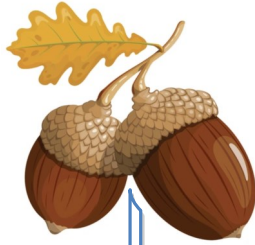

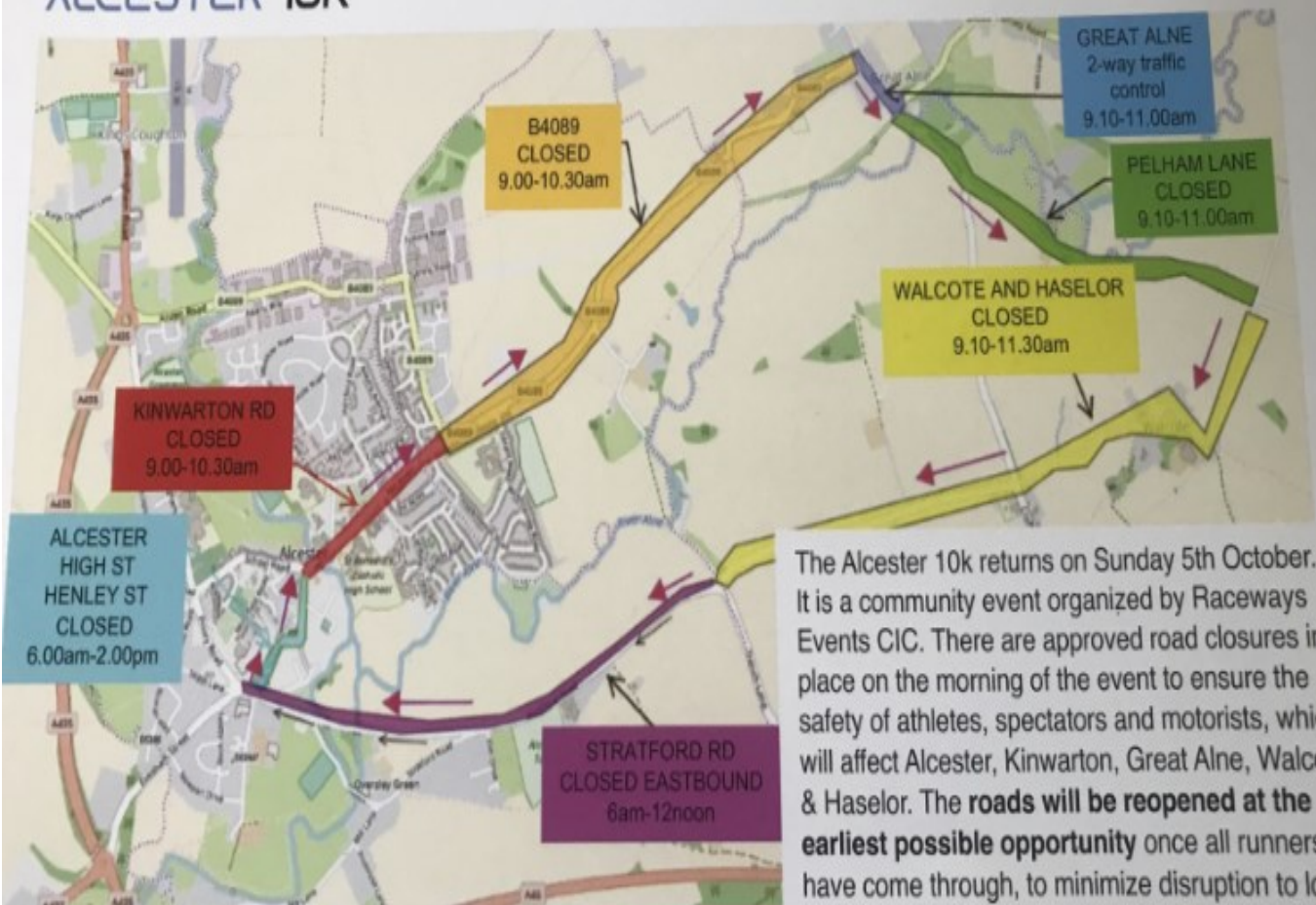
